### SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND ABSENTEE LETTERS ARE COMPULSORY

In accordance with The South African Schools Act (No. 84 of 1996), it is compulsory for children to attend school every day of the academic year. Furthermore, Manor Gardens Primary is an excellent school and therefore actively encourages 100% pupil and staff attendance as well teaching and assessing on every day of the academic term. Please note that children may not be absent from school on their birthdays.

#### Pupils are obliged to:

- Attend every prescribed school day,
- Never leave the school grounds in the morning before the school day starts or during school hours without the permission of the principal;
- On their first day back to school after an absence, bring a parents letter addressed to the principal explaining their absence;

#### Parents are obliged to:

- Ensure their children attend every prescribed school day;
- Provide a written request, addressed to the principal, with reasons for a child to be excused early from any school activity, or to arrive late at school or to be absent from school;
- Provide a letter, addressed to the principal, on the first day back to school from any absence which explains the reasons for the absence;
- Provide a professional doctor's medical certificate after an absence of three days or more on the first day back to school;
- Make dental, medical and remedial appointments outside school hours.
- Write an absentee letter on a separate piece of paper, and not in the homework notebook, as the letter will be placed in the child's file.

### STAFF ROOM AND STAFF GARDEN ARE 'NO GO' AREAS

The staff room and the garden outside the staffroom's sliding door are out of bounds to children and their parents. The pupil's lost property containers stored outside the staff kitchen may only be accessed from the corridors.

### PARENTS MUST REPORT TO THE OFFICE DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

Parents are reminded that they must report to the reception office during school hours for the secretary's assistance because they may not accompany late children or take forgotten items to the classrooms. On no account may parents arrive unannounced at any teaching or coaching venue during the school day. The learning process may not be disrupted under any circumstances.
