## TUCK SHOP: NO SPORTS DRINKS AND SODA CANS FROM FRIDAY 8 SEPTEMBER – JO BREDENKAMP

We have done some research on the effects of sports drinks and soda cans on children's health and wellbeing. Attached please find an article from The Star newspaper which explains that ideally we should only be drinking water and milk. Sports drinks are designed to replace electrolytes lost during intense physical activity of long duration. Sodas contain high levels of sugar (and caffeine) which is not conducive to optimal concentration for learning and a healthy diet. Therefore, as a school, the tuck shop will not be selling Energades and soda cans to pupils during the school day, as of Friday, 8 September 2017. The shop will continue to sell a selection of still, sparkling and flavoured waters, flavoured milk drinks and fruit juice to children. Soda cans will still be available for sale at social events to everyone but only to adults at sports matches and athletics meetings and galas.

### SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND ABSENTEE LETTERS ARE COMPULSORY

In accordance with The South African Schools Act (No. 84 of 1996), it is compulsory for children to attend school every day of the academic year. Furthermore, Manor Gardens Primary is an excellent school and therefore actively encourages 100% pupil and staff attendance as well as teaching and assessing on every day of the academic term. Please note that children may not be absent from school on their birthdays.

#### Pupils are obliged to:

- Attend every prescribed school day,
- Never leave the school grounds in the morning before the school day starts or during school hours without the permission of the principal;
- On their first day back to school after an absence, bring a parents letter addressed to the principal explaining their absence;

#### Parents are obliged to:

- Ensure their children attend every prescribed school day;
- Provide a written request, addressed to the principal, with reasons for a child to be excused early from any school activity, or to arrive late at school or to be absent from school;
- Provide a letter, addressed to the principal, on the first day back to school from any absence which explains the reasons for the absence;
- Provide a professional doctor's medical certificate after an absence of three days or more on the first day back to school;
- Make dental, medical and remedial appointments outside school hours.
- Write an absentee letter on a separate piece of paper, and not in the homework notebook, as the letter will be placed in the child's file.
